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Rajdeep Kaur Khakh receives suspended prison sentence for unlawful practice of medicine

VANCOUVER, BC: The College of Physicians and Surgeons of British Columbia (CPSBC) has announced that it has received a court order from the British Columbia Superior Court of Justice (SCJ) requiring the CPSBC to suspend the registration of Dr. Rajdeep Kaur Khakh for a period of 12 months, effective from January 1, 2019, until December 31, 2019. The court order was issued in response to a complaint filed by the CPSBC against Dr. Khakh for unlawful practice of medicine. The court found that Dr. Khakh had engaged in unlawful practice of medicine and that the CPSBC's action was justified. The court order also requires the CPSBC to pay the costs of the proceedings.

With these actions, the College is confident that the public interest has been served.

The College of Physicians and Surgeons is the licensing and regulatory body for all physicians and surgeons in the province. Governed by provincial legislation, the College's role is to protect the public by

establishing, monitoring and enforcing high standards of qualification and ethical practice across the province.
