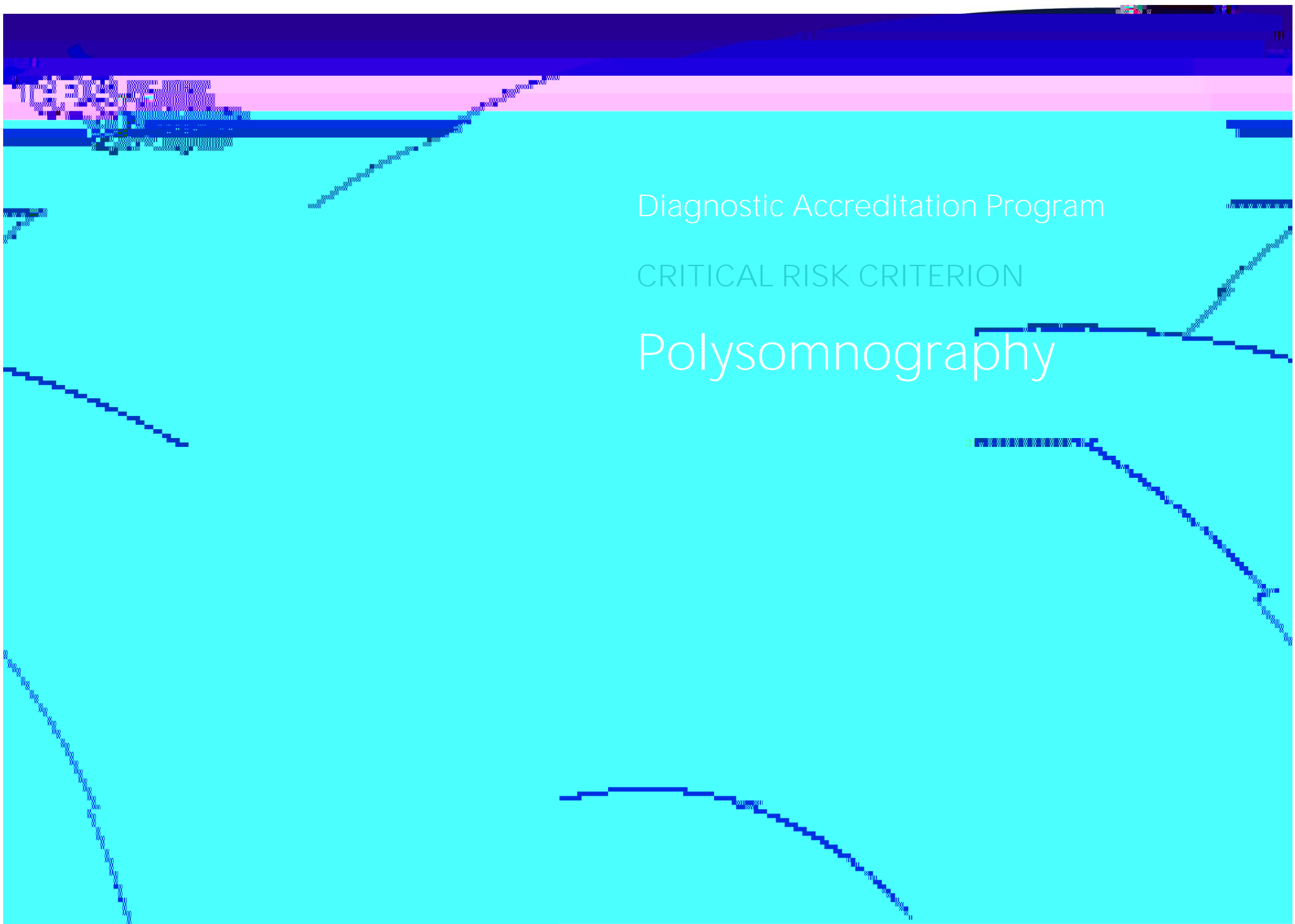

SSA2.1.2	M Emergency exit routes are marked and provide unimpeded exit.		C

Patient identification

No.	Description	Reference	Risk	Change
SPS2.1	Patient identification is confirmed prior to a patient's test or procedure by the individual(s) performing the test or procedure.			
PSS2.1.2	M Patient identification is confirmed prior to testing by the person(s) performing the test.		C	
SPS2.1.3	M At least two unique patient identifiers are used when verifying patient identification.		C
